Filing Your FAFSA Online

- Go to www.fafsa.ed.gov
- Get PIN. Click on **PIN Site**.

- Complete FAFSA. Click **START HERE**.

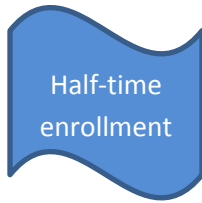
You'll need a PIN before you start the FAFSA. Click here to get one.

- File your FAFSA at the same time you apply for Grad Online admission.
- You must complete a new FAFSA every year.

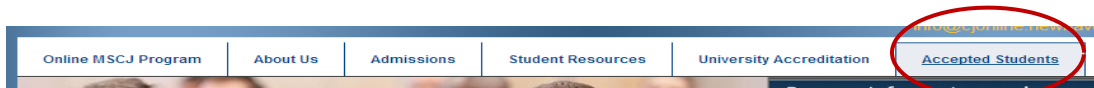


Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP)

- Students must be in good academic standing and making satisfactory academic progress to be awarded for the following academic year. You must complete all the credits for which you received financial aid in the previous academic year and must maintain a minimum 3.0 Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA). **Failure to do so will result in the loss of financial aid eligibility.**

Login to your financial aid account

- Go to <http://cjonline.newhaven.edu/> Click on the **Accepted Students** tab.



- Click on **My Financial Aid** found in the bottom left corner of the page.

- Enter your Student ID area in the **Log In** box.

- You will be asked to answer security questions to verify your identity, and then you may create your PIN.
